SERMON: JESUS - IMMANUEL

I. THE MEANINGS OF THE NAMES

- A. A name denotes a person, establishes his identity, represents his person, and describes him (parallel ideas for animals and objects) or his actions.
- B. The names of God are a Revelation of God - Exodus 3:15; 6:3; 33:19
- C. The name, Jesus
 - 1. The N.T. equivalent of the O.T. Joshua
 - 2. Joshua = The LORD, or I AM, is Salvation.
 - 3. Jesus = The LORD is Salvation
- D. The name, Immanuel
 - 1. O.T. name for Virgin's Son
 - 2. Immanuel = Heb. 'God is with us'
- E. The equating of the name, Jesus, with the name, Immanuel.
 - 1. Jesus = The Lord is Salvation (who is with His people to save them from their sins) Salvation is mentioned - (people ~~are~~ implied)
 - 2. Immanuel = God is with us (to save us from our sins) People are mentioned (the salvation is implied)
 - 3. The person accomplishing salvation is the focus of Matt. 1:21

Same concerns in Daniel 9 + the 1 - People, forgiveness of sins -
